

Special Equipment Plates for ATVs

New Information

Effective September 15, 2011, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) used in agricultural operations qualify for the issuance of special equipment (SE) identification plates. Questions regarding the use of helmets and other safety requirements should be referred to the California Highway Patrol.

Procedures

Process SE identification plates for ATVs used in agricultural operations as implements of husbandry following current procedures outlined in the *Vehicle Industry Registration Procedures Manual*, §16.080.

Background


Legislation added ATVs used in agricultural operations to the definition of implements of husbandry in the *California Vehicle Code (CVC)*, §36005.
